Summer School Overview

Magic Years International School (MYIS) Summer School consists of two sessions during the summer months of June and July offering a balance of academics, sports, art, and nature education.

Each session lasts three weeks and has a schedule filled with fun and educational activities for children ages 1 to 9 years old. The program is open to all nationalities and to children from all schools.

Summer school is an opportunity for your child to continue being part of a community atmosphere as well as exploring a range of “international-minded” engagements that supports individual interests and development. It is also an opportunity for newcomers to Bangkok to meet other children at school during the quieter days of summer and get familiar with the school culture and routines before the regular term starts in August.

Academic Programs (ages 6-9 years)



Reader's & Writer's Workshop

This year, Magic Years will be hosting an intensive "Reader's & Writer's Workshop" during the summer for students ages 6-9 years for the purpose of learning to write for a variety of audiences and purposes and to develop into lifelong writers. This approach to writing was popularized by educators at Columbia University. Building on the IB PYP transdisciplinary framework, students will use modeled writing to independently draft creative pieces of writing and then confidently present their work.

Field Trips (ages 3-9 years)

Children's Discovery Museum & Park

The Children's Discovery Museum located near Chatuchak Weekend Market encourages a hands-on approach to learning with interactive displays called 'discovery learning process', whereby children enter the experience and participate in learning rather than remaining a passive viewer.



Koh Kret Adventure

Koh Kret is a small island in the Chao Phraya River that we will visit by a small ferry. We will explore the island, which is one of Thailand's oldest settlements of Mon people. We will observe the traditional rural settlements, view handmade pottery, and enjoy the the nature of the island.

LEGO® Construction

with Bricks 4 Kidz

Bricks 4 Kidz is a popular children's edutainment program from the US. Classes will explore architecture, engineering and technology concepts using LEGO® bricks. Students focus on exciting themes including space, inventions, famous buildings, and natural disasters. The activities are designed to trigger young children's lively imaginations and build their self-confidence.



Farming & Gardening

with Thai Organic Food

In farming and gardening with Thai Organic Food, children will be introduced to organic agricultural systems, engage in hands-on experiences growing vegetables, and learning about the importance of organic foods. Thai Organic Farm was founded in 2000. They are certified by Organic Agriculture Certification Thailand and accredited by IFOAM.



Soccer

with CUKI TOTS

CUKI TOTS is a positive, entertaining pre-school football programme delivered in a responsive environment. Instructed by FA qualified coaches and early years school teachers, the CUKI TOTS football programme teaches fundamental football techniques and basic life skills in an exciting and energetic, team play environment.



Art

with Attic Studios

Attic Studios will provide unique painting and drawing lessons for children during the summer. The teachers will encourage expressive and exploratory art making by looking at different art inspirations for each session. Through art lessons children will develop their fine motor skills, cognitive skills, problem solving abilities and emotional outlet to express their feelings.

Favorite Programs (all ages)



Cooking

Students will be given an opportunity to be independent chefs, while developing a whole new sense of food, as they engage in the following experiences: exploring recipes, trying new foods, using various kitchen equipment, food preparation, and creating new dishes. Children will also practice safety in the kitchen and tune their fine motor skills.



Arts & Crafts

Students explore and express their feelings through art. In Arts & Crafts, children will be able to create, draw, paint, and sculpt the world they see and imagine. Children will be able to find inspiration and learn how to express themselves through art. Arts & Crafts will provide a space to explore and experiment while developing knowledge of art and craft abilities.



Gym

Gym helps children become skillful, knowledgeable and expressive movers. The children learn a variety of fundamental movement skills, such as leaping, balancing, rolling, throwing and catching. Children will use their bodies to solve problems, tackle appropriate physical challenges, manipulate equipment or apparatus, and express themselves in a range of situations



Swimming

Swimming helps young children develop physically, mentally and emotionally and is a great opportunity for them to take risks and acquire an important life skill. With the supervision of an experienced instructor and the classroom teachers, the children learn to swim in a safe, fun and challenging environment.



Thai Language

In Thai class, children learn Thai language through meaningful activities, games, stories and songs. The children learn to recognize the Thai alphabets, sounds and Thai numbers. The children have the opportunity to practice dot writing of the Thai alphabets and single words. The children also communicate with short conversations and questions about themes.

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Pricing

Program Structure

Summer School consists of two sessions during the summer months of June and July for children ages 1 to 9 years old. Each session lasts three weeks.

Non Magic Years Students

Registration is open to non Magic Years students as well. The language of instruction at the camp is English, however students of all English language ability levels can enroll.

Snack and Lunch

A morning snack and afternoon lunch are served daily to the children. The school menu is made available to parents in advance. In case your child has a food allergy, please inform the school ahead of time.
